

## WHAT IS ART?

Art is self-expression. Artistic involvement promotes the development of visual literacy and creative and critical thinking. The art department at Bradford High offers studio experiences for students with a vocational interest and those with art in mind as a career. The arts are an essential human experience. Students need not consider themselves talented to enroll in art. Art at BAHS teaches systematic thinking, planning and investigation by emphasizing individualized approaches to a variety of media and subjects.



## ART 1

THIS COURSE IS REQUIRED BEFORE TAKING CERAMICS, PAINTING, SCULPTURE, OR DRAWING. TO BE ABLE TO TAKE ANY OF THE ABOVE COURSES, STUDENTS MUST PASS ART 1. ART 1 IS THE ONLY ART COURSE AVAILABLE TO FRESHMEN.

Art 1 is an introductory course for students in vocational interest or those choosing a career in art. Art 1 integrates studio production with criticism, aesthetics and art history to give students an awareness of visual expression in its many forms. Challenging the student's creative abilities while working on the skills of art is the purpose of this course. Students are required to examine how art is made and the thinking processes behind their creativity. The traditional media will be principal means of studio production.

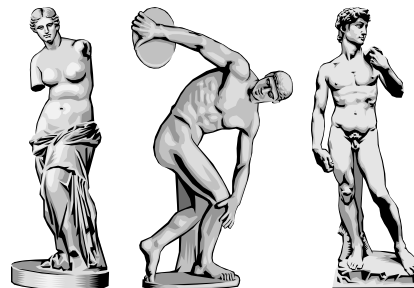
If you have an interest in art, you should really consider joining this club. It gives you a chance spend time with people who share the same interests as you outside of school, and have lots of fun doing it.
