ACTION SKILLS PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

Contest Area: To be assigned upon arrival

Clothing / Safety Requirements

Official attire of the occupational area of the demonstration, including footwear

Or

SkillsUSA Official Attire

Eligibility

Registered SkillsUSA members enrolled in a corresponding program

Letter of Eligibility from school official on school letterhead stating contestant classification under the provisions of PL 105-17

Tools / Materials Supplied by Contestant

All materials and equipment needed for the demonstration to be completed, two times, if required

One-page résumé

A 3"x 5" card of indicating the topic and purpose of the demonstration, as well as the contestant's technical program area presented to the program chair

Equipment Supplied

Time keeper

All necessary information and furnishings for judges and technical committee

An 8' by 12' space with one 110-volt (15 amp) electrical outlet and one 30" by 96" table

Scope of the Contest

- Any skill may be demonstrated if it is related to the occupational program of the contestant
- The demonstration shall be five minutes in length, but shall not exceed seven minutes
Penalty: Five points will be deducted for each 30 seconds (or fractions thereof) under five minutes or for each 30 seconds (or fractions thereof) over seven minutes
- Contestants will be allowed three minutes to set up the demonstration and three minutes to clear the demonstration room
Penalty: Five points will be deducted for each 30 seconds (or fractions thereof) over the three minute allowance
- Visual aids will be prepared by contestants. No professionally prepared visual materials are permitted
- A SkillsUSA student member may assist with set up or dismantling of the demonstration or may be used as a prop or a model, but he/she may in no way assist with the presentation
- Contestants will not take the skills-related written or Professional Development Test as outlined in the general regulations
