Competition Title: **COSMETOLOGY**

Clothing/Safety Requirements:

School uniform and Shoes (no open toes)
No school names
I.D. number will be provided
All work clothes must be free of insignias/labels

Eligibility:

Registered Skills USA member enrolled in a Cosmetology program.
Students are required to have proof of training form and a one page resume.

Tools and Equipment/Materials:

1. Supplied by the Host School:
 - a. Vanities, mirrors, tables and styling chairs
 - b. Towels
 - c. Mannequin-holders for all areas of this contest
 - d. All necessary information and supplies for judges and technical committee
 - e. Any and all pictures or literature of styles, haircuts and technical's
 - f. First aid kit
 - g. Blood spill kit
2. Supplied by contestant:
 - a. Mannequin – ******(Burmax, Sam II – Brown (S153) – for the haircut)
 - b. Mannequin – ******(Burmax, Gabriela 560) – for the long up-do
******The mannequin heads are available for purchase through the Cosmetology department at the Clarion County Career Center (S153 - \$28.50) (Gabriela 560 - \$39.99). If you are purchasing the heads from the Career Center, please provide payment on the day of competition and make checks payable to CCCC.
 - c. Cutting shears
 - d. Thinning shears
 - e. Razor and spare blade

- f. Thermal tools (flat iron and/or curling iron)
- g. Blow dryer
- h. Styling products of choice
- i. Finishing spray
- j. Combs
- k. Brushes
- l. Spray bottle (filled with water)
- m. Rollers (no brush or Velcro types permitted)
- n. Clippies or hair clips
- o. All competitors must create a one-page typed résumé

Scope:

Students will be tested as follows:

Each event will be timed. The maximum amount of time for each task is indicated.

Students will be evaluated using the following criteria:

1. Safety.
2. Care and proper use of tools.
3. Job performance. (Amount of work done and the quality)
4. Personal appearance. (Clothes, shoes, eye protection)
5. Verbal terminology. (Cosmetology trade terminology)
6. Neatness and Accuracy.

Contest:

The contest is divided into two separate skills performance tests, one written examination. Contestants will demonstrate their ability to perform jobs or skills from the following list of competencies as determined by the host school.

1. Woman's Cut and Design (CO 2.0, 3.0)
 - a. Time allotted: 1 hour
 - b. Contestant must be able to duplicate a pre-determined haircut and style, which has been selected by the host school.
 - c. 600 possible points
 - d. Cut and style will be scored as a completed design
 - e. Blow dryer and thermal tools (curling iron, flat iron, etc.) may be required to complete style
 - f. Styling products of choice may be used

2. Long Hair Design (CO 1.0)
 - a. Time allotted: 1 hour
 - b. Contestant will be asked to create a long hair design of their choice (on a long hair mannequin).
 - c. 200 possible points

- d. No ornaments or hairpieces allowed
- e. Any technique may be used (such as braiding, twisting, rolls, loops, etc.)
- f. Contestants may apply makeup to the model, but they must complete the Application during the time allocated.
- g. Earrings only may be added once hair design is completed provided it is done within the time frame allowed.

3. Written Examination

- a. Contestants will answer 50 multiple-choice questions covering all aspects of Cosmetology.
 - i. Milady's Textbook – 2012
 - ii. Time allotted: 30 minutes/50 questions
 - iii. 100 possible points

Contest Rules:

- 1. All contestants must keep their working area clean and organized.
- 2. All contestants must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the contest.
- 3. Professional attitude and communication is expected throughout the contest
- 4. Once time is called, contestant must stop working. Touching the hair of the mannequin after time is called will result in three penalty points.
- 5. Cell phones must be turned off during the contest.
