Competition Title

Food and Beverage Service

Clothing / Safety Requirements

Official SkillsUSA white long-sleeved dress shirt, white oxford long sleeve shirt, black dress slacks or skirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie, black leather work shoes, black socks or hose (optional) black belt. No waiter's jacket, bow ties, cummerbunds or vest are permitted.

Eligibility

Open to active SkillsUSA members enrolled in programs that include food and beverage service as a part of their instruction and occupational objective.

Tools / Materials Supplied by Contestant

- *One ink pen/ one No. 2 Pencil for written test*
- *Hair restraint if hair extends below the collar*
- *Table crumbers, lighters, or note pads are optional*

Equipment

All equipment: food, beverages, chairs, tables, flatware, trays, table settings, cloths and napkins, guest checks, check presentation folders, contest materials, menus and description of the daily chef featured dishes will be provided.

Scope of the Contest

Written Test will be limited to:

A written knowledge test of approximately 30 true/false and multiple choice questions assessing food and beverage operations, service styles, techniques, dining room equipment, limited wine knowledge, sanitation, and understanding of hospitality and guest relation principles, and understanding of culinary terminology.

Performance Test will be limited to:

- *One formal table setting*
- *One informal table setting*
- *Ability to describe food items on a given menu and ability to present a menu.*

- *Greeting and seating of a guest*
- *Taking a food order*
- *Serving and cleaning techniques*
- *Check preparation and presentation*
