**Scope of the Contest**

Written Test will be limited to:

There is no written knowledge exam for this contest.

Performance Test will be limited to:

The contest requires the demonstration of a performance of an occupational skill accompanied by a clear explanation of the topic through the use of explanation of the topic through the use of experiments, displays, or practical operations.

**Contest Guideline:**

1. An actual technical skill must be performed as opposed to an illustrated talk.
2. Note cards and reference materials are not permitted.
3. Any technical skill may be demonstrated. The skills do not have to relate to the occupational program of the contestant.
4. The demonstration shall be at least 5 minutes in length but shall not exceed 7 minutes. Penalty: 5 points will be deducted for each 5 seconds under 5 minutes or for each 30 seconds over 7 minutes.
5. Time will be started when the demonstration begins. The time keeper will signal the speaker at 5 minutes, 6 minutes, and 6 minutes 30 seconds.
6. Contestants will be allowed 3 minutes to set up the demonstration and 3 minutes to clear the demonstration. 5 points will be deducted for each 30 seconds over the 3 minute allowance.
7. Any visual or auditory aids are to be prepared by the contestants.
8. The contestant will not mention his or her name, school, city or state.

9. The demonstration is an individual performance, however assistants may be used to set up and dismantle the demonstration. Models or assistants may be used in the demonstration but will not say or do anything that assists the demonstration.
10. Basic safety practices related to the skill performed must be followed. Safety violations will be subject to 1-10 point penalties.
