Performance: Contest will consist of Building a Basic Web Site and a short test on theory. This contest will evaluate students' excellence, creativity and professionalism in the field of web design.

Conditions: Contest will be limited to 2.5 hrs.
Labor will be supplied by Lawrence County CTC. No materials should be brought in electronically or otherwise.

Winner shall be decided on the basis of their work using the following criteria:

Written Test:

Will consist of basic knowledge of HTML, Dreamweaver and web design principles.

Practical:

- A) Overall Design—all pages are formatted attractively including a page banner on every page
- B) Successfully managing the web site
- C) The use of appropriate graphics
- D) The use of alternate text on graphics
- E) Including a table on one of the pages
- F) Adding a rollover picture on one of the graphics
- G) Correctly linking all pages together
- H) Including at least one animated button and one scrolling marquee
- I) Including one animated banner on one of the pages
- J) All copyright laws are to be followed
- K) Theme and content must be educational in nature
- L) Content must support the theme

Contestant can score a maximum of 200 points.
