

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS LIST- BAHS 2011 (ROUND 2)

The following scholarships are available only to the Bradford Area High School seniors. Applications are available in the Guidance Office. Deadline on Scholarships is May 03, 2011 (except the scholarships with *'s they have special deadlines).

1. Ambrose, Brenda Memorial Scholarship
This scholarship will be awarded to a senior girl who best represents the following:
 - A. Participation in girl's interscholastic sports
 - B. Plans to continue her education
 - C. Positive overall character
2. Andrus Family Good Citizenship Award
This scholarship will be awarded to a senior who best exemplifies the following qualities:
 - A. Considerations of others
 - B. Contributions to school and community
 - C. Positive leadership qualities
 - D. Ability to cooperate with others
 - E. Desire to continue education
3. Bradford Area Education Association Scholarship (BAEA) (2 Individual Scholarships)
This scholarship will be awarded to a senior who best exemplifies the following qualities:
 - A. Academic achievement
 - B. Involvement in student activities
4. Bradford Area High School Alumni Association Scholarship
Scholarship to be awarded to a student who shows school accomplishments, future educational plans and recognition of current and future needs of Bradford and the surrounding area.
5. *Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #2432 Deadline of April 22, 2011
 - A. _Senior graduating in June, 2011
 - B. Must have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is a current member of Fraternal Order of Eagles or Eagles Auxiliary
 - C. Must be attending a 2 or 4 year trade school – proof of enrollment is required
6. Heffner, Samuel Sr. Memorial Scholarship
 - A. Been a B.A.H.S. full time student for at least two years
 - B. Been accepted in an engineering program at an accredited institution
 - C. Participated in student activities
7. Howard, June A. Nursing Scholarship
 - A. Senior who has been a B.A.H.S. full time student for at least two years
 - B. Been accepted in a registered nursing program at an accredited institution
 - C. Participated in student activities
8. Key Club Scholarship
 - A. Key Club Members Only
 - B. Essay
 - C. Community Service

9. Kiwanis Vo-Tech Scholarship
Given to a graduating senior who is planning to enroll in a two year Vo-Tech program or a certificate program.
10. Lechner, Brian Vocational Scholarship
 - A. Senior who is presently enrolled in one of the vocational programs at B.A.H.S.
 - B. Will be continuing their education in a technical/trade program
11. Mottey, Mary Memorial Scholarship
Senior who has met all requirements established by the National Honor Society Adult Committee which includes- scholarship, leadership service composure.
12. Student Council Membership
Two awards will be given, one to a student enrolled in a four year academic program and the other will be a student enrolled in a vocational program. These awards will be given to a senior who:
 - A. Has excelled in their educational program
 - B. Been accepted at an institution of higher education
 - C. Has attained a competitive class rank
 - D. Has participated in extra-curricular activities
13. Tanner, Ernest Memorial Scholarship
Student pursuing post-secondary education in the study of geology and/or petroleum engineering. If there is not a student who falls within this category, the income shall be paid to a graduating senior designated by a committee consisting of the high school's principal, a guidance counselor and two teachers.
14. *Vigliotta, Memorial Scholarship Fund
This is the annual endowed scholarship. Student must write a brief essay describing your interest in receiving this award, educational and career goals.
15. Wheeler, R.L. Scholarship
Scholarship will be awarded annually to a Senior Girl who has completed the following:
 - A. Lettered at least two years in either Girls Basketball, Girls Volleyball, or Girls Track
 - B. Participated in at least one other varsity sport
 - C. Maintained a "B" (80%) scholastic average or better
 - D. Must be accepted to and enrolled in curriculum at an institution of higher learning

16. *PLCM Scholarship (Due April 18th)
Participants are asked to reflect on the theme "Sailing into Healthy Communities" by describing the key factors that constitute a healthy community.
17. *McCarl, Foster Jr. Scholarship (Due May 1st)
Scholarship will be awarded to students pursuing degrees in Plumbing, HVAC, Engineering or Construction related fields of study.
18. *Will to Win Scholarship (Due April 30th)
Scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior with asthma and who excels in performing arts, visual arts, community service, athletics, or science.
