

Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) Program

Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) will help families cover the cost of breakfasts and lunches their children would have been eligible to receive for free or at reduced price through the National School Lunch Program. P-EBT benefits for the 2020-21 school year are only available to students who ***received virtual or remote instruction full or part-time within a month (i.e., school closures, virtual/remote instructional days, absences, etc.)***.

It may take until mid to late June for you to receive your card. Please wait until June 30, 2021 before reporting to the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services that you have not received a card for your child or if you have questions regarding the amount of benefits you received. Do not contact The Bradford Area School District as we will not be able to assist you with those questions.
